WALLEYE/WHITE LAKE UPDATE

We have good news regarding the walleye rearing pond. As many of you are aware, the most successful walleye planting is achieved when the walleye fry are raised in captivity to the fall fingerling size before they are released into the lakes.

We have wanted to do this for years but have been limited by the capabilities of the Muskegon Pond to remain filled, cool, and stable over the hot summer months. With the current pond set up the pump intake is often left high and dry when the river level drops in the hot summer months. Without the ability to replenish water lost from evaporation the pond overheats and the walleye die. The good news is that the DNR received a \$170,000 grant to upgrade the pond with high-capacity wells to provide a stable water source through the summer. Engineering studies were completed Sept. 18th and the project is going forward.

Mark Tonello is the regional DNR biologist in charge of White Lake. He is our key partner for improving the quality of fishing in White Lake. He is responsible for the overall health of the fishery and sets the stocking rates for walleye, musky and anything else that have been planted in the lake. With funding to the DNR fisheries division being very low, he does not get to do as many scientific surveys and samples to assess our fisheries as he needs. Therefore, he relies heavily on reports

and anecdotal evidence to help inform his decisions. He is reaching out to our membership to help keep him informed. Please feel free to call him with fishing reports, observations, or just to talk in general about White Lake. He is very interested in fishing reports in general, particularly related to walleye, musky, and the general quality of fishing in White Lake. His number is
