## Board / Membership Meeting Minutes

### Attendees

Board members and general membership present (names not consistently captured in transcript).

### General Membership – Open Floor

- Screen Room / Clubhouse rental rules – weddings & alcohol language

#### Discussion Summary:

- Question raised regarding “no wedding receptions” language.
- Weddings/receptions have historically occurred with safety stipulations.
- Alcohol language and insurance considerations discussed.

#### Decision:

- Remove “no wedding receptions” restriction.
- Retain careful alcohol-related language.
- Allow member wedding reception this summer pending rule updates.

#### Action Items:

- Revise Clubhouse Usage Rules (fees, capacities, outdated references).
- Bring revised document to next board meeting for approval.

### Committee Reports

#### Building & Properties

1. Water System / Backflow Preventer
  - Rebuild if guaranteed not to leak; otherwise replace.
  - Complete before March 27 (fish fry, restroom/kitchen compliance).
2. Campground Grills

- Decision needed: reinstall grills or require campers to bring their own.

### **Internet & Cameras**

- Approved switch to Frontier fiber internet (~\$169/month).
- Approved purchase of 12-camera security system (~\$1,200, local recording).

### **Shore Committee / Marina**

- Slip fee collections ongoing; late fees apply.
- Volunteer training planned for spring boat launch (April target).
- Safety protocols emphasized (PPE, no alcohol, procedures).

### **Dredging / Seawall**

- Contractor coordination ongoing.
- Verify EGLE wetland constraints before spoil placement decisions.

### **Fundraisers & Events**

Fish Fry – Friday, March 27, 2026

- Members only; donation-based pricing.
- Proceeds designated for tree replacement.

Club Swap / Flea Market – Saturday, May 16, 2026

Fourth of July BBQ – volunteer lead confirmed.

### **Treasurer's Report**

- FY26 Net Loss: (\$100,071.24) primarily due to seawall work.
- Bank Balance as of Feb 28, 2026: \$212,318.50.
- Motions approved: bill payments, treasurer report, tax preparation.

### **Campground Decisions**

- Proceed with remaining work to finalize permits (up to 24 sites).
- Treat campground sites similar to slips with deposits/reservations.

## **Facebook Administration**

- Executive board members to hold admin rights; chairs as moderators.
